Oliver paused the video and zoomed into the corner of the screen.



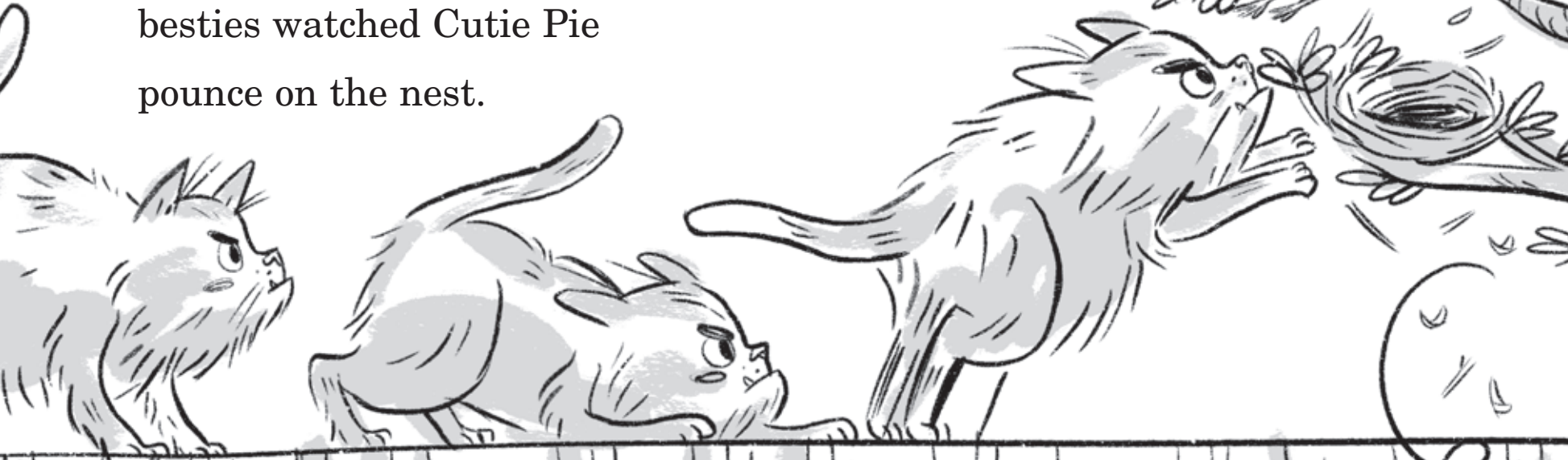
A big fat ginger cat was
